This Annual Report presents our program impact for the December 31, 2023 year-end. It outlines our approach to serving the individuals and families in need in Radcliff, KY, and neighboring communities. The Food Pantry, in partnership with Feeding America, provides weekly grocery bags to families needing food.

The Soup Kitchen is the second most visible ministry within NHFLM. It provides hot meals to those who might go hungry without access to our dining facility.

Hope On a Rack is a visible ministry offering free clothing, shoes, coats, and other items for the entire family. They also provide business attire for job interviews.

Our senior nutrition program, The Senior Feeding Program, is in partnership with Warm Blessings. It provides meals to senior citizens 65 years of age or older who live in Hardin County, KY.

The Derek L. Brown Gymnasium is an important source of income for New Hope Family Life Ministries. Hardin County citizens use the facility for sports programs and other activities, and the gymnasium remains a popular rental venue for events like seminars, weddings, and banquets.

"The Afterschool Program" is a recently launched initiative aimed at helping students who struggle academically. Our volunteer tutors include former educators still passionate about fostering lifelong learning through relationship-driven educational support. As more community members have learned about our program, our numbers have grown, and we look forward to welcoming even more students next semester!

New Hope Family Life Ministries offers an environment that will strengthen the community and nurture relationships through recreational, educational, social, spiritual, health, and wellness opportunities while curtailing hunger one meal at a time. Together, this is what New Hope Family Life Ministries. is represented by the "Six Programs, One Purpose: A Beacon of Hope For The Community." 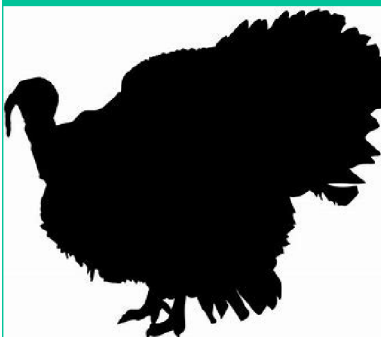

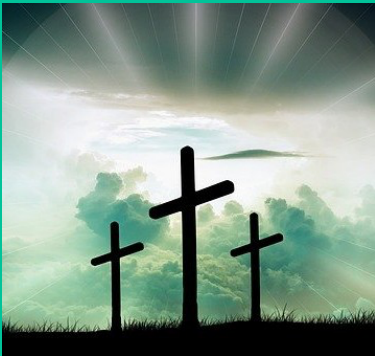
