# A Message from the Chairman of New Hope Family Life Ministries

This Annual Report reflects our ministry's impact as of year-end, December 31, 2024. You will find our strategy for serving individuals and families in need in Radcliff, KY, and the surrounding communities. Perhaps the most visible ministry is "The Food Pantry," which partners with Feeding America and other community resources and provides weekly grocery bags to families needing food items. Through these efforts, the Food Pantry addresses immediate nutritional needs and fosters a sense of community, hope, and spiritual well-being among those we serve.

"The Soup Kitchen" is the second most visible ministry with NHFLM offering nutrition meals with compassion and respect, helping individuals maintain their dignity during difficult times.

"Hope On a Rack" is the third most visible ministry that offers free clothing, shoes, coats, and other items for the whole family. Hope On a Rack doesn't just provide clothes; we offer hope, empowerment, and a sense of belonging to everyone who walks through our doors.

Hope On A Rack is not just covering bodies - "Hope On a Rack is restoring confidence, enabling job readiness, and fostering a sense of community."

"The Senior Nutrition Program" partners with Warm Blessing to provide meals. Senior citizens in Hardin County, KY aged sixty-five (65) and older are eligible for our program. The Senior Nutrition Program not only ensures that our elders received essential nourishment but also promotes a sense of community, dignity, and well-being among the seniors we serve.

"Youth Enrichment After School Program" is a newly established experience targeting students on the lower end of academic achievement. Many of our volunteer tutors are former educators who are still passionate about creating lifelong learners through relationally driven educational assistance. As word spread throughout our community, our numbers steadily increased. We hope to see even more students attend next semester.

Derek L. Brown Gymnasium provides significant financial support to New Hope Family Life Ministries. The DLB facility enhances the lives of this community and promotes a vibrant, unified atmosphere.

The gymnasium is a valued rental facility in our community for events, including marriage ceremonies and banquets

New Hope Family Life Ministries, offers an environment that will strengthen the community and nurture relationship through recreational, educational, social health, and wellness opportunities while curtailing hunger one meal at a time.
